WHO SHOULD USE TOOTH WHITENING?

Teeth whitening is a safe, comfortable way to get a bright, white smile. We recommend tooth whitening to anyone age 13 or older who is looking to improve the appearance of their smile.



HOW LONG UNTIL I SEE RESULTS?

Results and treatment time may vary depending on the level of staining and whiteness desired. It is recommended to use for 5-10 days and then touch up every 6 months.



IS THERE ANYTHING YOU NEED TO AVOID?

It is best to avoid dark liquids while whitening to receive the best results. Drinking dark liquids through a straw after whitening can help reduce future staining.

OPALESCENCE GO FAQ

- **How old should you be to begin using the trays?**
 - 13 years and older
- **Can you whiten longer than 10 days/trays?**
 - We recommend only whitening for the initial 5-10 days and then waiting 6 months for maintenance.
- **Can you whiten while you are pregnant or breastfeeding?**
 - Studies have not been done on women who are currently pregnant or breastfeeding, so it is best to defer your whitening.
- **Can I still drink coffee and other dark liquids?**
 - It is not recommended to drink dark liquids while whitening. After your treatment, using a straw to drink darker liquids will help reduce future staining.
- **Will I have sensitivity from whitening?**
 - Tooth sensitivity is a relatively common side effect of teeth whitening. If sensitivity occurs, it is most often temporary and will go away when you've completed the whitening process. If you do experience tooth sensitivity, there are ways to treat it using desensitizing toothpastes like Sensodyne or Preident.
- **Do my trays need to be refrigerated?**
 - Your trays will sustain longer efficacy if kept in the refrigerator and out of direct light.
- **Does it contain fluoride?**
 - Opalescence's patented formula contains PF (potassium nitrate and fluoride).
